Classes

Everyone wishing to climb at Stoneworks **must** take a one hour safety course. In the course, we teach you beginning belaying and tying a figure eight follow-through knot for Top Rope climbing.

Group Information

Reservations must be made two weeks in advance so we can schedule the additional staff needed.

Tax exempt organizations must supply a copy of the state issued tax-exempt form upon arrival. Your organization must pay with one check in order to avoid paying sales tax.

Rules & Information

- You **must** be 16 years old to belay.
- No age restrictions for climbing.
- Everyone must read and sign a release form.
- Minor's release form must be signed by parent or guardian. If signed off premises, it must be notarized.
- Valid state issued ID required to verify age.
- If any of these requirements are not met, the individual will not be allowed to climb at StoneWorks.
